Thank you for your dedication in making the **Canada Disability Benefit** better! Together, we can make a difference.

How to Prepare:

- **Understand the Issue:** Familiarize yourself with the key messages and the urgent need to improve the CDB. Review the one-pager and talking points provided.
- **Practice Your Story:** Be ready to share a personal or community story that highlights the importance of the CDB. Stories resonate with decision-makers.
- **Coordinate with DWP:** Attend the town hall and use the materials provided to feel confident in your advocacy role.

How to Get Meetings With Your Member of Parliament (MP).

- Identify Your MP: Find your local MP using the House of Commons MP Search Tool.
- **Request a Meeting:** Use the email/letter template provided to request a meeting. Highlight your role as an advocate and your interest in discussing the CDB.
- Follow Up: If you don't hear back within a week, follow up with an email or call.

What to Say:

- Introduction: Introduce yourself and your connection to the issue.
- **Key Points:** Share the key messages and a personal or community story to illustrate the importance of the CDB.
- The 3 Asks: Urge the MP to support:
 - 1. **Increasing the amount** of the CDB to lift people out of poverty.
 - 2. **Keeping the application process easy and accessible**—no restrictive barriers.
 - 3. **No clawbacks** from any level of government.
- Ask them to publicly support these improvements and push for them in decisionmaking spaces.

What to Do During the Meeting:

- Be Respectful: Listen actively and thank the MP (or their staff) for their time.
- **Stay Focused:** Stick to the key messages and avoid getting sidetracked.
- Take Notes: Record key points discussed, including commitments or questions.

How to Follow Up:

- **Send a Thank-You Note:** Email the MP (or their staff) to thank them for the meeting and reiterate your key points.
- **Provide Additional Info:** If the MP requested further details, follow up promptly with the necessary materials.
- **Stay Engaged:** Keep the conversation going by sharing updates from the campaign and asking about progress on their commitments.
